

GET TESTED!

COVID 19 COMMUNITY TESTING SITE

May 15-19 2020

FOR: Stockbridge-Munsee Community, Menominee Indian Tribe, Menominee County residents

WHERE: W2727 Our Children's Road, Keshena, WI (Transit facility)

WHEN: May 15-19 10 am- 6 pm daily. No appointment needed

HOW: Drive through vehicle testing, results available approximately 48 hours after test. Testing is done by nasal swab. You must provide working phone number to receive results. Results can be given only to you.

WHY: Few tests limited our ability to identify people with COVID-19 infection. Widespread testing is now available. Finding people with infection will help stop the spread of virus and save lives.

WHO: **Anyone 5 years old or older**

Anyone who has 1 or more of the symptoms below or was referred by public health

- Fever of 100.4 degrees or higher
- Sore throat
- Runny nose
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Vomiting or Diarrhea
- Headache
- Episodes of shaking and chills
- Loss of taste or smell
- Achy Muscles

OR

Referred by Public Health – Per SMHWC Medical Director, anyone in the Stockbridge-Munsee Community who wants to be tested.
