

COVID-19 Workplace-Related Medical Surveillance Program

The Stockbridge-Munsee Community has established a workplace-related medical surveillance program to identify people who may be infected or exposed to COVID-19, a communicable disease, in order to limit impacts to the workplace. Testing under this program is conducted through the Stockbridge-Munsee Health and Wellness Center.

- If you are suspected of having or being exposed to COVID-19, you will be referred for assessment and testing as necessary.
- You will be referred for assessment and testing if you were identified as being in contact with someone who tests positive (either directly or, in some instances, indirectly) as part of contact tracing.
- You will also be referred for periodic testing as part of mandatory testing for all employees.

As these referrals are part of an workplace surveillance program, the Stockbridge-Munsee Health and Wellness Center shares your test status and related isolation/quarantine status with the Stockbridge-Munsee Community Occupational Health Department and/or Human Resources Department as your employer.
