

Election Health Notice:

Chapter 26A of tribal law establishes the Health Center as the Tribe's public health authority. It authorizes the Health Director to issue orders for people to quarantine or to isolate.

People under quarantine orders should be just staying at home. This means not leaving home to vote. The people under isolation orders (the ones who haven't tested positive for the disease) can leave home for essential purposes so long as they take precautions to minimize contact with other people. They may leave home to vote under the isolation orders.

October 10, 2020 Election Proceedings:

Masks are required for all.

Children under the age of 21 will not be allowed in the voting area.

When you enter the building, you will be required to sanitize your hands.

You will then proceed to the first Clerk station where you will present your Tribal Identification card. You may be asked for your name and/or Tribal Identification number.

You will then proceed to the next Clerk station where your identity will be verified.

You will then proceed to the Teller station where you will receive your ballot.

You will then be given a pen to use for marking your ballot. The pen is yours to keep, so please take it with you when you leave the voting booth.

After you have made your choices in the voting booth, or at the separate table for those who need or want to use it, you will place your ballot into the tabulation machine.

You will then proceed out of the building via the marked door.

We ask you to please maintain social distancing and remain at your vehicle until there is room for you to enter the building to vote.
