

Request for Proposals

Mini Farm Business Grants

The Native American Agriculture Fund has provided the Stockbridge-Munsee Community with \$6,500 for grants to Tribal Member Farmers. Approximately 6 grants will be awarded, and an applicant may request \$500 to \$1500 for qualified expenses.

To be eligible, an applicant must operate a “Farm” type business that produced, sold, or distributed any agricultural products during 2020 and incurred expenses of over \$500 or in the case of a beginning farmer must submit a detailed business plan.

Funds may be used for: equipment, soil amendments, supplies to add value to a farm business or that create efficiencies within the business.

Funds may not be used for: general utilities including animal feed and fuel and where tribal law prohibits the sale of communal resources.

Applications are due to the Tribal Secretary, by 4:00 pm January 15th, 2021. Applications may be submitted in person or by mail:

Applications will be reviewed by the NAAF Mini Farm Business Grant Committee and successful applicants will be notified by February 1st, 2021.

If awarded each applicant will receive two distributions of their award: 50% at the time of award and 50% upon the submission of expense receipt(s). All receipts must be submitted by May 1, 2021.
