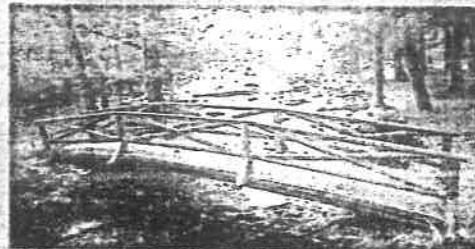

## INDIVIDUALIZED CARE

Shaaxkooxweewaakan HWC intends to provide each participant a richly developed plan with input from each supporting team member of the HWC. The treatment plan will be person centered and take into consideration the structure of the participants family, peer groups, social environment, employment factors, education, history of chemical addiction.

Each participant will work during the intake process to begin formulating their steps and designing their path which may include, but not limited to: group counseling, individual counseling, in day treatment, medical care, telehealth care, family / child counseling services, or even inpatient care. Along with treatment needs the participants will construct their own ancillary services and program supports with the Court Coordinator, such as; education and job training opportunities.

Community involvement is a key ingredient in Shaaxkooxweewaakan HWC. Our goal is to help connect participants back to their own community and reconnecting them to the importance of their culture, while integrating the values of family, accountability, respect, self-fulfillment, strength, and resiliency.

## ELIGIBILITY

This is based on legal determination based on the nature and type of charges filed against a respondent as well as that respondent's prior criminal history. Pursuant to this policy – the Tribal Court makes all eligibility decisions. Participation can be mandated by court order if contributing factors present urgency.

## PARTICIPATION

Drugs / substances were major part of current charge(s).

No extreme violence offense against any other person(s).

Participant is 17 yrs. of age or older.

Must plead guilty or no contest to current charges.

Signs of abuse or dependency on substances.

Not sentenced to correctional facility.
