Anyone living within the Stockbridge-Munsee Reservation boundaries is eligible to receive a food package (based on eligibility criteria):

“Indian Households” (a household which there is at least one enrolled, federally recognized Tribal member in household), living outside the Reservation, but within the rural areas of Shawano County, the townships of Red Springs and Bartelme are eligible to receive a food packages.

### **FoodShare for the State of Wisconsin (Federal Program) –**

Created to help stop hunger and to improve nutrition and health. FoodShare helps people with limited money buy the food they need for good health. <https://www.dhs.wisconsin.gov/forwardhealth/apply.htm>

- Child Care Assistance
- General Assistance (GA) – this program provides cash assistance for single Native Americans ages 18 and older. Eligible if reside within the Stockbridge-Munsee Boundaries and have no income.
- Temporary Assistance For Needy Families (TANF) – Provides welfare services to Native American families with, or expecting a child, in need of temporary aid and services. Must reside within the Stockbridge-Munsee Boundaries.

Transportation to appointments will be scheduled as follows: Elderly, Disables, All Others.
