ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES: Applicant must be an adult Stockbridge-Munsee tribal member 18 years of age or older at time this application for assistance is submitted. Applicant must use the assistance provided under this program for the intended purpose of promoting food and utility security thereby ensuring adequate and healthy food, as well as health and power, for themselves and their family.

APPLICABLE LEGAL STANDARDS: This program has been authorized by resolution by the Stockbridge-Munsee Tribal Council. Such resolution, along with this application and a program instructions letter, provide written guidance on the operation of the program. The program is for the promotion of the general welfare of tribal members and therefore is not lavish or extravagant or compensation for services. It is intended to fall under the IRS income exclusions for tribal general welfare programs (26 U.S.C. 139E).
